Alumni Award \$2,500 (over four years)

Student must attend a two, or four-year college and must have attended DHSW for three years.

American Legion/Charles F. Moran Post 45 In memory of Joseph E. Miller

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance to a worthy student possessing good moral character, evidence of good citizenship, be in need of financial aid, and has been accepted at an accredited college enrolling in a 4 year degree or equivalent program to major in Business, Finance, or in the specifically related fields of Economics or Accounting.

Amina C. Valocchi Scholarship, Downingtown Area Chamber of Commerce \$1,000

This scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior with a "B" or better scholastic average. The student must be accepted into a two or four-year school.

Animal Science/Veterinary Medicine Scholarship \$200

Student who plans to pursue further education in the animal sciences or a veterinary medicine related field.

Beaver Creek PTO Scholarship Fund 2 \$250 awards

Student must have good citizenship and school/community involvement. Student must have a GPA of 2.75 or greater and have attended Beaver Creek for at least three years. Student shall not have accepted any other elementary school scholarship.

Bradford Heights Home & School Scholarship 2 Scholarships \$250 awards

These scholarships are offered to seniors who attended Bradford Heights during one of their primary grades (1-5). Students must be accepted into a technical, two or four-year school.

Brandywine Wallace Elementary School Faculty and Staff Scholarship \$300

The scholarship will be awarded to a graduate of DHSW who meets the prerequisites. The student must have a B average and demonstrate good citizenship in school and community, and also plan to attend a school for further education including technical, two or four-year colleges.

Brandywine Wallace Home & School Association Book Scholarship

Two scholarships, \$250 each awarded to a boy and a girl. Student must have attended Brandywine Wallace for a minimum of four years. Student must be planning post-secondary education in a technical school, two or four-year college.

Chester County Mothers of Multiples Club Scholarship \$1,000

In memory of Jeremy Wilson, a scholarship will be awarded to a senior who meets the following criteria: 3.5 minimum GPA, demonstrated leadership and community service, and acceptance to a college/university for the fall/winter of 2010. Preference will be given to multiples and siblings of multiples.

Dayne J. Thomas Memorial Scholarship Fund

Please submit essay no less than 500 words describing a "One of a kind person" in your life. One letter of recommendation should accompany your application. It should be from an individual familiar with your character and potential for completion of a 2 or 4-year college program.

Delta Kappa Gamma \$500

Scholarship will be awarded to a female student planning to major in education at a 4-year college/university.

Dr. Julius Margolis Scholarship (multiple awards) for a total of \$23,500

This scholarship is to support the study of medicine including premedical courses, nursing, lab technicians, pharmacists, and X-ray technicians.

Downingtown Area Education Association Scholarship \$2,000 (\$500 per year)

Student must attend a four-year college and plan to major in Education. Student must have attended DHSW for three years.

Downingtown Area School District Support Staff, Teamsters Local 384 \$250

To be eligible for this book scholarship, you must be a graduating senior of a parent who is a member of Teamsters Local 384. The student must be continuing education in a two-year, four-year or vocational school.

Downingtown Cheerleading Academic Scholarship 4 \$500 awards

Student must have been a cheerleader for at least two full academic years and maintained a 3.0 or better GPA. Student must be planning to attend a four-year college.

Downingtown High School West Campus Home & School Association Book Scholarship 4 \$250 awards

This is awarded to an all-around good student and citizen. The student must declare a desire to seek education in a post high school program. The student's parent must be a member of the Downingtown West Home & School Association.

Downingtown Middle School Home & School Association Scholarship 2 \$250 awards

The student must have attended Downingtown Middle School. The student must have demonstrated good citizenship as well as community involvement. The student must have maintained a GPA of 2.75 or greater while attending DHSW. The student must be planning to seek education in a post-high school program.

East Brandywine Fire Company Scholarship In memory of Richard Bond \$500

This is awarded to an outstanding senior who has volunteered time to various community activities. The student must have done volunteer work within the past year.

Ellen Ann Roberts Scholarship

The Ellen Ann Roberts Scholarship will be offered to a Republican woman graduating from Downingtown West who will be attending Delaware County Community College. This scholarship will honor her memory and her belief in the achievement of women.

Friends of Brian Houshower Memorial Scholarship \$1500

This scholarship is for students who have a GPA between a 2.5 and 3.0. Applicants must have involvement in at least one activity at DHSW.

Florence A. Moore Scholarship Fund \$300

This scholarship is provided to honor the memory of Florence A. Moore, a long time Downingtown School District educator. Applicants must live in the East Brandywine Township or Downingtown Borough, have a 2.8 or higher GPA, and plan to obtain a degree in education.

Girls Athletic Association \$250

This scholarship is for a student who has been an active member of G.A.A. for four years. The student must have at minimum a 2.5 GPA and have been involved in at least one service oriented activity each year.

John L. Leonard Memorial Scholarship

The recipient of this scholarship must have attended Beaver Creek Elementary, be accepted at a 2 or 4-year degree program, and have a 3.0 GPA or higher.

John Shafran Memorial Scholarship \$500

The recipient of this scholarship must have a 3.0 GPA and be in at least three activities.

Krapf Scholarship \$1,500

The Krapf Scholarship will be awarded to a student who has demonstrated good citizenship as well as school or community leadership. The student shall have at least a 3.0 GPA.

Landon Family Foundation Scholarship \$3,000

This scholarship will be awarded to a senior who will attend a four-year college. The student must have a minimum GPA of 3.5, three school activities and a minimum of two community activities. Being an officer of a club or organization and other leadership roles will also be considered.

Leigh Spallone Memorial Scholarship \$1,500

The student must have at least a combined 3.0 average in English for the junior year and the first three quarters of the senior year. The student must be accepted into a four-year college program and shall have attended Downingtown for the entire junior and senior years.

Lions Club Scholarship

The student must plan to attend a four-year college, have a minimum GPA of 3.0, and attended DHSW for 10th, 11th, & 12th grades. The recipient must plan to major in the medical or allied health profession.

Michael Bartone Memorial Scholarship \$2,000-\$3,000

The student must be accepted into an accredited technical, trade, vocational or similar institution of continuing education.

Mutual Fire Foundation Scholarship 3 \$1,000 awards

The recipient of this award must be planning to attend a 4-year college/university.

Students will be evaluated in the areas of academic achievement, community service, and leadership.

Patty Bennett Memorial Scholarship \$500

The student must be a member of DHSW diving team during junior and senior years or a competitive gymnast during junior and senior years, or plan to attend a Christian College or Christian University.

Philip T. Swank Memorial Scholarship \$1,000

This scholarship is given to a senior accepted at a four-year college. The senior must have a "B" average, do community service and have financial need. Applicant must be a member of the Alert Fire Company or at least a nuclear family member of an active member.

Ray DiSerafino Memorial Scholarship \$250

This scholarship is memory of Ray DiSerafino, a long time Downingtown School District educator. The applicant must be a senior who plans to pursue a 2 or 4-year college. The senior must have at least a 2.0 GPA

and be active both in the community and DHSW.

Ryan P. McCall Track & Field Scholarship \$1,250

This scholarship is for a senior male who participates in Cross Country and/or Track and Field. The student must have a minimum GPA of 3.0.

St. Anthony's Women's Auxiliary Scholarship \$250

This scholarship will be awarded to senior with the following prerequisites: 3.0 GPA, demonstrated good citizenship, and school and community involvement. Preference will be given to a student that is a relative of a member of the St. Anthony's Women's Auxiliary or St. Anthony's Lodge.

Shamona Creek Elementary School Scholarship

The student must have attended Shamona Creek Elementary School and have a 3.0 GPA. The student must be planning to attend a four-year university and have not received scholarships from other Downingtown school sources.

Susan Patrizio Johnson \$500

The student must have a 3.0 GPA and have earned at least one varsity letter. The student must have attended DHSW for at least three years. The student must be planning to major in Education (Special Education preferred).

Todd K. Delaney Scholarship

The student must be accepted into a state school or similar institution of continuing education.

West Bradford Elementary Home & School Association Scholarship \$500

The student must have attended West Bradford Elementary School and demonstrated scholastic excellence and interest in leadership in student activities. The student must have demonstrated service to the community and be accepted in an accredited program of higher education.

West Bradford Youth Athletics Scholar Athlete Award

This is awarded to a senior who plans to attend a two or four-year college or vocational/technical school. The student must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and have participated in West Bradford Youth Association athletics for a minimum of three seasons.

West Chester Fish, Game, & Wildlife Scholarship \$1,000

This Scholarship will be awarded to a senior who plans to pursue a 4-year degree in any of the following disciplines: Fisheries Management, Wildlife, or Conservation.

William J. Dunn Memorial Award \$200

The student must be the relative of a Marine or plan to enter Marine service. The student must be involved in school activities and community service projects. The student must be planning post-secondary education or planning to enter the field of accounting, banking or economics.

Women's Club of Downingtown \$2,000 each

Two scholarships offered to students graduating from Downingtown West who will be continuing education at a two or four-year school.
