

## Frequently Asked Questions about West Bradford's Kindergarten

1. Do you have a full day kindergarten program?  
No, we have two sessions: a.m. 9:00-11:40; p.m. 12:30-3:20
2. Is there bus service for kindergarten?  
We have a.m. drop off service for the whole school and p.m. dismissal for the whole school.  
Parents are responsible for a.m. kindergarten pick up at 11:40 and p.m. kindergarten drop off at 12:30.  
We do not have midday bus service available for kindergarten students.
3. Does kindergarten have snack?  
Yes, snack details are discussed at Kindergarten Open House and Back to School Night.
4. What programs do you use?  
Reading –Harcourt Trophies K-5  
Math—Scott Foresman/Addison Wesley-K-5  
Handwriting-Zaner/Bloser  
Spelling-Sitton Spelling  
Science-Foss Science program
5. When are parent-teacher conferences?  
December-after the first marking period  
March-after the second marking period  
Parents are welcomed to call and make an appointment for a conference throughout the year before or after school as needed. Notes and emails are also welcomed!
6. Does my child need to take a test to enter kindergarten?  
No, assessments are not given prior to kindergarten registration.
7. What assessments are given throughout the year?  
Dibels-3 times a year  
Reading and Math assessments are given throughout the year as themes and units are completed.
8. Are parents allowed in the classroom during the day? Yes, parents sign up and assist at daily classroom centers and are welcomed to help out on special events days.
